### **STD Clinic**

**Cost: Free**

Walk-in hours from 8:00-11:00am & 1:00-4:00pm. No appointments; please call ahead: 841-4100. Get tested for STDs, including HIV/AIDS (both anonymous & confidential), Hepatitis B vaccinations.

### **Family Planning**

**Cost: Sliding Scale**

Well woman exams, Pap smears, & birth control. By appointment only. Call: 841-4188

### **Emergency Contraception**

**Cost: Free**

Emergency Contraception (Plan B, Morning After Pill) available on walk-in basis Mon-Fri from 8:00-11:00am & 1:00-4:00pm. Please call ahead: 841-4100.

**Cost: Free**

WIC is for pregnant, breastfeeding or postpartum women with children under 5 yrs. Qualifying families receive supplemental food, nutritional education, referrals. Appt only, call: 841-4173.

### **PE/MOSAA**

**Cost: Free**

Presumed Eligibility/Medicaid On Site Application Assistance. Apply for Medicaid or Emergency Medicaid on a first come/first-served basis on Tuesdays & Wednesdays from 8:00-11:00am & 1:00-4:00pm; Thursdays 8:30-11:30am. See the back of this form for a list of the *Requirements for Medicaid Application*. Please call ahead: 841-4100.

### **Pregnancy Testing**

**Cost: Free**

Tuesdays & Wednesdays from 8:00-11:00am & 1:00-4:00pm; first come/first-served only. Please call ahead 841-4100.

### **Childhood Immunizations**

**Cost: Free**

Childhood immunizations (shots) are offered by appointment only on Thursdays, 8:00-11:00am. Please bring your child's shot record. Call: 841-4100 to make an appointment.

### **Vital Records**

**Cost: \$10 per copy**

Get a birth certificate for someone born in New Mexico, usually within 24 hours. Must bring government-issued, unexpired photo ID. Cost is \$10 per copy, paid in cash, check, or money order. NO CREDIT CARDS. Mon-Fri, 9:00-12:00 & 1:00-4:00. For more info call 1 (866) 534-0051.

### **Public Health 4 M4M**

**Cost: Free**

Free STD testing and Hepatitis A & B shots for gay and bisexual men. Held the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday of each month from 5:00-8:00pm. For more information call 841-4150.

### **Harm Reduction/Needle Exchange**

**Cost: Free**

Clean needles & supplies, and a safe disposal of used needles. Free HIV, Hepatitis C testing, and Hepatitis A & B vaccines available. Mon-Fri 8:00-11:00am & 1:00-4:00 pm. Call ahead: 841-4100.

### **Suboxone**

**Cost: Free**

### Requirements for Medicaid Application

**Proof of Identity:**

- ❖ ID or current Driver's License
- ❖ Children over 5, shot record or school ID
- ❖ For children under 5, parents must complete a Declaration of Identity

**Proof of Citizenship:**

- ❖ US Passport or Birth Certificate
- ❖ Resident Aliens must present Resident Alien Card(s) and must have lived in the U.S. as a legal resident for at least 5 years.

**Proof of Social Security Number:**

- ❖ Social Security Card or a letter from the New Mexico Social Security office showing you have applied for a copy of the card for all applicants.

**Proof of Income:**

- ❖ Verification of any income into the household in the past 4 weeks. One month's worth of check stubs (MOST RECENT).  
 If one is missing a letter from your employer stating the GROSS amount for that missing check will do.  
 If you've just started a job and don't have proof of income or not enough for one month, a letter from your employer stating your hire date, hours of work to be expected per week and how often you will be paid will be sufficient.  
 Bi-Monthly (twice a month) - Bi-weekly (every two weeks) - Weekly (once a week)

**Proof of Residency:**

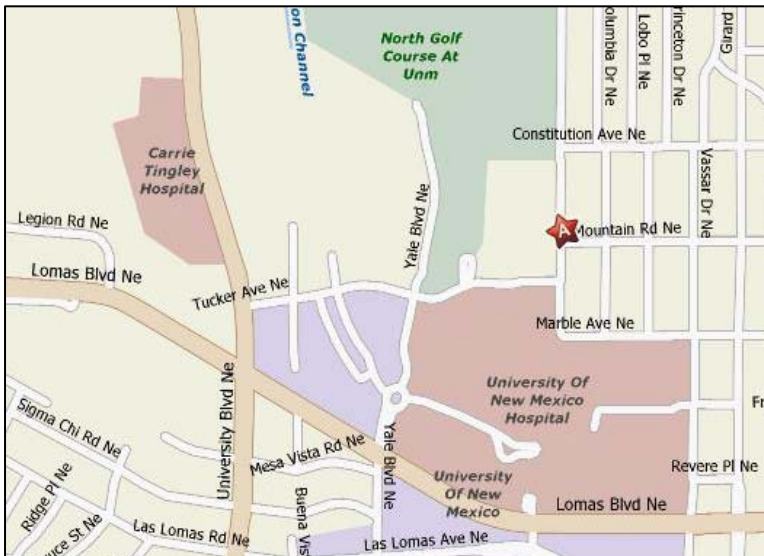
- ❖ Utility Bill: One of the following: Gas or Electric bill with name and address on it to prove residence only. If your bills are included with the rent, a copy of the rental agreement or a copy of mortgage will be sufficient. OR
- ❖ Letter Stating Living Arrangement: For example: If living with a parent or grandparent a letter stating living arrangement, completed in ink or type script and needs to include the current date, name, address and signature.

**Proof of Insurance:**

- ❖ If you have Health Insurance you must present your insurance card(s).

**Proof of pregnancy:**

- ❖ A letter or Memo from a Medical Center stating that you have a positive pregnancy with an EDC (Expected Date of Confinement) or delivery date.
