NewMexiKids/Medicaid Eligibility:

The first opportunity to apply for Medicaid for your infant is prior to leaving the hospital. Also you can call 1888-997-2583 (NEWMEXIKIDS.) You will be sent a Medicaid application and referred to an enrollment site in Santa Fe County. No/low cost health insurance for children to 19 years of age. Includes regular check-ups, doctor visits, dental visits, hospital care, prescriptions, vision/hearing exams and glasses. Other services may be covered if they are medically necessary. Children are eligible for no cost health care if their family's income is less than 185% of the federal guidelines poverty but is also eligible for low cost healthcare if household income is 185% - 235% of the Federal poverty Guidelines. **Guidelines are subject to change.** Remember, you will need to make an appointment. You will need to take the parent's identification, child's birth certificate, child's social security card, proof of residency (phone bill, utility bill, rent receipt or letter from landlord), and proof of income (last four check stubs if working, copies of checks received or letter from employer).
