The T-bar allows an individual with poor motor skills to access the remote control.

The bottom of the T-bar was made with splinting material so it could be easily molded around the original control. The top of this section was solid splinting material to allow it to take a screw.

The top section of the T-bar was made with ABS plastic. The ends were curved up using a heat rod. This section could also be made with splinting material.

**The top and bottom sections were attached with a screw.
This item could also be made with wood.**

Worked well for this individual. He learned to control the remote car independently and really enjoyed this as a hobby!
