# Overview of Systemwide Home Visits in March – April 2023

- 6800 + home visits completed
- Analysis of findings and lessons learned to inform on-going visits occurring
- Medicaid contractor conducting analysis of systems and will produce short-term and longterm recommendations
- 290 RORAs filed (all waivers)
- Potential ANE cases being investigated
  - Number of substantiations TBD



## Scope of Wellness Visits

- Health and safety
  - Signs of abuse neglect or exploitation
  - Adequate food
  - Observable hazards in environment
  - Observable injury or healthcare concerns not being addressed
  - Do the individual and their supports present at visit know how to report ANE



# **Complaints We Heard**

- Seemed threatening and were fear-based
- Demanding participants-return home when someone showed up unannounced
- Need Spanish speaking people to do visits
- Low-income families felt profiled and targeted
- People showing up with no form of identification
- Demands to see bedrooms felt like searches
- Fear of retaliation for not letting people in the home, i.e calling police
- Violation of human rights



#### Positive Feedback We Heard

- Appreciated by most families
- Observed many people in services living safe lives in the community
- Identified potential problems that could be corrected before bigger issues arise (RORAs)
- Able to implement immediate action and safety plans for any potential ANE cases



# Sample Issues Observed by Visitors

- Families did not understand waiver program (e.g., questions about payment)
- DSP did not know individual well or how to report ANE
- Homelessness and poor housing conditions
- Home safety issues brewing (e.g., dirt -mold, leaky faucets, tripping hazards, missing interior doorknob)
- Supports that need verification of HRC and ISP (e.g., locked fridge)

# Current Monitoring Practices in Home Setting by Providers

#### Case Management

- Monthly face to face visits for adults /quarterly for children
- At least quarterly in home for SL, IMLS, FL and CIHS
- Missing a required home visit for children and adults without a paid LCA (i.e. respite only)

#### **Service Coordinators**

Monthly for SL, IMLS, FL and CIHS
