- 1) Review and revise draft Dec. ACQ agenda
- 2) Discussion on the report on the ACQ By-Laws Comm. for Dec. agenda:

 - ADDCP and the NM Caregivers Coalition met with Senator Ortiz y Pino, Rep. Liz Thomson and DDSD leadership.
