The grounds for the NCA are found in the following DOH rules: DOH Rule 7.27.2.14(G)(3)(c) NMAC, "[G]rounds for denial, suspension, revocation or other disciplinary action are: ... unprofessional conduct". The motion was seconded by Brandon Sam. None were opposed and the motion was approved.

Larry Tackman moved in the matter of Parker Brownell, EMT-Paramedic; that the Commission, pursuant to its authority under NMSA 1978, § 24-10B-5.1, authorized the EMS Bureau of the New Mexico Department of Health ("DOH") to issue a Notice of Contemplated Action (NCA) to suspend Parker Brownell's EMT-Paramedic license for 90 days in the state of New Mexico. The grounds for the NCA are found in the following DOH rules: DOH Rule 7.27.2.14 (G)(3)(e) NMAC, "[G]rounds for denial, suspension, revocation or other disciplinary action are: ... negligence in the delivery of emergency medical services"; DOH Rule 7.27.2.14 (G)(3)(n) NMAC, "[G]rounds for denial, suspension, revocation or other disciplinary action are: ... any false, fraudulent, or deceptive statement in any document connected with the practice of emergency medical services"; and DOH Rule 7.27.2.14(G)(3)(c) NMAC, "[G]rounds for denial, suspension, revocation or other disciplinary action are: ... unprofessional conduct". The motion was seconded by Mary Bailey. None were opposed and the motion was approved.

Larry Tackman moved in the matter of Andrew Schwerdel, EMT-Intermediate; that the Commission, pursuant to its authority under NMSA 1978, § 24-10B-5.1, authorized the EMS Bureau of the New Mexico Department of Health ("DOH") to issue a Notice of Contemplated Action (NCA) to suspend Andrew Schwerdel's EMT-Intermediate license for 30 days in the state of New Mexico. The grounds for the NCA are found in the following DOH rules: DOH Rule 7.27.2.14 (G)(3)(e) NMAC, "[G]rounds for denial, suspension, revocation or other disciplinary action are: ... negligence in the delivery of emergency medical services"; DOH Rule 7.27.2.14 (G)(3)(n) NMAC, "[G]rounds for denial, suspension, revocation or other disciplinary action are: ... any false, fraudulent, or deceptive statement in any document connected with the practice of emergency medical services"; and DOH Rule 7.27.2.14(G)(3)(c) NMAC, "[G]rounds for denial, suspension, revocation or other disciplinary action are: ... unprofessional conduct".
