### Influenza (also called the Flu)

### COVID-19

- It's not too late to get vaccinated.

### **Pneumococcal Disease**

- Pneumococcal vaccine can prevent pneumonia caused by pneumococcus bacterium, which can be a complication of influenza.
- Pneumococcal disease refers to a wide range of infections that can be caused by pneumococcal bacteria, including pneumonia, meningitis, sinus infections, bloodstream infections, sepsis, and ear infections.
- The best way to prevent pneumococcal disease is through vaccination.
