

New Mexico Department of Health 2022 Weekly Infectious Disease Report Week 19 May 8, 2022 - May 14, 2022



Monthly Trends for Selected Notifiable Infectious Diseases As of May 14, 2022



Number of Reported Cases of Campylobacteriosis by Month




Number of Reported Cases of Giardiasis by Month




Number of Reported Cases of Pertussis by Month




Number of Reported Cases of Salmonellosis by Month
