

New Mexico Department of Health 2022 Weekly Infectious Disease Report Week 24 June 12, 2022 - June 18, 2022

This report is prepared by the Epidemiology and Response Division (ERD) Infectious Disease Epidemiology Bureau (IDEB) for notifiable infectious diseases reported through the New Mexico Electronic Disease Surveillance Systems (NM-EDSS). NM-EDSS is a web-based system used by public health staff throughout the state to track investigations of suspected, probable and confirmed cases of notifiable infectious diseases. Data for the current year are provisional and subject to change upon the completion of ongoing disease investigations. Data for prior years are also subject to minor revisions due to corrections or identification of historical cases. 
Monthly Trends for Selected Notifiable Infectious Diseases As of June 18, 2022

Includes probable and confirmed cases only.




Number of Reported Cases of Campylobacteriosis by Month

Number of Reported Cases of Salmonellosis by Month





2022 --- Average, last 5 years






Number of Reported Cases of Shigellosis by Month
