Hospitalized COVID-19 Patients Must Be Reported Immediately to the New Mexico Department of Health

April 20, 2020

COVID-19 or laboratory-confirmed SARS-CoV-2 virus infection is immediately notifiable to the New Mexico Department of Health (NMDOH). In an effort to contain this pandemic disease and ensure healthcare capacity statewide, NMDOH is reliant on all healthcare providers to report hospitalization of patients with COVID-19.

NMDOH should be immediately notified for any of the following:

- Hospital admission or inpatient diagnosis of COVID-19 in a patient
- Discharge of a COVID-19 patient
- Death of a COVID-19 patient

All reports to NMDOH should include:

1. The disease or condition being reported
2. Patient information
 - Name
 - Date of birth or age
 - Race/ethnicity
 - Address
 - Telephone number(s)
 - Occupation
3. Physician or licensed healthcare professional's name and telephone number
4. Healthcare facility name and telephone number
