Traveling with Cannabis



Travel across state lines with cannabis is <u>illegal</u> based on federal statutes.

Every state has different cannabis laws which regularly change. Some states **do not allow cannabis legally**; some have medical cannabis programs; some states have reciprocity programs (see below); and some have adult-use cannabis (recreational use).

Find out the cannabis laws and regulations in other states you plan to visit so you do not run into legal issues. **Know before you go!**

Reciprocity



Check directly with the states you visit to see if they have a reciprocal program to allow medical cannabis patients to purchase while visiting and what their requirements are to participate:

- Some states require submitting forms ahead of your visit and these can take time to process (sometimes over 30 days); and,
- Some states require you have specific documents in your possession.

Ensure you have your New Mexico Medical Cannabis Card and your New Mexico Driver's License (or State ID) with you and they are **active and current** for the entire time you are travelling.
