The legal consequences of driving high

Driving under the influence of cannabis is **illegal** and carries serious legal consequences including fines, license suspension, and even imprisonment.

Here are some rules you should know before you drive.

- You can use cannabis at home, but it is **illegal to use it on the road or in a public space.**
- **Never drive or use heavy machinery** while under the influence of cannabis.
- **Patients** enrolled in the Center for Medical Cannabis are allowed to drive with **up to 425 units at any one time.**
- It is **illegal to take cannabis** to airports, national parks, schools, government buildings, or federal courthouses.
- **Transporting cannabis across state lines is illegal.**
