NEW MEXICO HEALTH ALERT NETWORK (HAN) NOTICE New Mexico Communications Hub

Background:

The Public Health Division of the New Mexico Department of Health is developing an online Health Communications Hub that will connect primary and behavioral health care providers, and public health officials across New Mexico. The intent is to build community, share evidence-based practices, and enhance the ability to prevent and respond to health emergencies statewide.

We are seeking input from providers on the development of Hub and would especially like to invite feedback from physician members, as well as physician assistants, nurses/nurse practitioners, psychologists and psychiatrists, Community Health Workers, and other health professionals or paraprofessionals.

Recommendations for Clinicians:

Between now and the beginning of May, we will conduct focus groups to understand providers' priorities and proposed uses for the Hub, challenges they anticipate, and potential solutions to those challenges.
