about your medical cannabis UNIT limits!

What is a unit?

- 1 unit is equal to 1 gram of dried flower.
- For edibles, topicals, and tinctures, 1 unit is 200 milligrams (or 0.2 grams) of THC.

Purchase limit:

- Patients enrolled in the Center for Medical Cannabis can buy up to **425 units** (or 15 ounces) of medical cannabis or medical cannabis products over a rolling 90-day period.

Tracking your purchases:

- Your units are tracked every time you buy medical cannabis products from a dispensary. Each time you buy a unit it is deducted from your total count of 425 units.

Example: if you buy 25 units worth of medical cannabis today, your balance will reduce to 400 units.

90-day period:

- The units you buy are not gone forever!
- Each individual unit you buy will automatically be added back to your total **90 days** from the time it is purchased.
- There is no single renewal date for all 425 units.

Check your units:

- You can check on your units by registering online at the Center for Medical Cannabis Online Patient Portal website:

Just follow the directions on the patient portal website and you will be able to see your sales history from the last 90 days!

Reaching your unit limit:

- If you reach your 425-unit limit, adults 21 and over can still purchase recreational cannabis! Be aware that you will be taxed when purchasing recreational cannabis.

Staff of the Center for Medical Cannabis and medical providers cannot add more units to a patient's overall total of 425 units. You can petition to have units added by petitioning the Medical Cannabis Advisory Board.
