



Las siguientes instrucciones lo guiarán paso a paso para configurar su cuenta en TrainNM.

Cómo iniciar en TRAIN

IMPORTANTE: Debe seguir todas las instrucciones hasta el final para asegurarse de que su cuenta quede completamente configurada. Si no lo hace, no podrá acceder a las capacitaciones que necesita.

Para comenzar con TRAIN, primero debe crear su cuenta.

1. Ingrese a TRAIN en: www.train.org/nm/welcome
2. Cree una cuenta: Haga clic en el botón “Create an Account” (como se muestra en el círculo de abajo).
