Respondents in rural ZIP codes had more negative perceptions of the harms and benefits of cannabis use, while those in urban ZIP codes had more positive perceptions.

After adjusting for median household income, the price per gram of medical cannabis was 6% lower relative to the rest of the United States.

Accuracy & Reliability in Findings

The cannabis use questions employed in this survey are supported by at least 20 scientific publications. These studies show that participant self-reports about their substance use, including cannabis, are reliable (for example, if you ask them twice in a day about their pastmonth use, it will be the same) and match biologically verified cannabis use patterns (they are accurate).
