- 1) Check in and welcome.
- 2) Clarified the roles of BOD and non-Board members and brainstormed ideas of how to ensure BOD members only are speaking during non-Public Comment time.
 - The ACQ Admin. will send a clean copy of current BOD members to the ACQ co-chairs to use when they call on people to speak.
 - People will be reminded that there are two Public Comment periods available.
 - The Exec. Comm. and DDSD leadership will host Listening sessions bi-monthly (the opposite month from the ACQ meetings) to hear people's concerns/questions, etc. These meetings will be held on ZOOM from 1:00-2:00.

 - There are three critical areas that are not currently represented on the BOD: case management, therapies, and behavior support consultants.
 - A proposal will be drafted to revise the ACQ By-Laws to add these positions.
 - This will be discussed and voted on at the October ACQ meeting.
