
Qualifying Conditions: patients must have at least one of these to participate in the Medical Psilocybin Program.



- Current:
 - PTSD
 - Substance use disorders
 - End of life care
 - Treatment Resistant Depression

Clinical Warning: Patients with the following conditions are eligible to receive psilocybin, but treatment should proceed through stabilization, consultation, careful clinical judgment, and risk mitigation planning where clinically appropriate.



- **Psychiatric History:** psilocybin may exacerbate or precipitate psychiatric symptoms, particularly those involving psychosis, mood instability, or impaired reality testing such as:
 - Bipolar I
 - History of mania
 - Active eating disorders or significant malnutrition
 - History of recurrent or recent self-harm or self-injurious behavior
- **Cardiovascular and Medical History:** psilocybin can cause transient increase in heart rate and blood pressure and may pose risks in patients with underlying cardiovascular or neurologic disease such as:
 - Uncorrected or clinically significant electrolyte abnormalities, especially hypokalemia and hypomagnesemia
 - Prior CVA/TIA
- **Neurological and cognitive Conditions:** altered perception and cognition may worsen underlying neurological vulnerability such as:
 - Dementia or moderate to severe cognitive impairment
 - History of traumatic brain injury with residual deficits.
 - Seizure disorders, particularly if poorly controlled, recent, or associated with a loss of consciousness.

Specialist Review: patients that meet any of the following criteria must have 2 practitioner signatories, the original psilocybin practitioner and a specialist in the criteria the pt met.

- Psychiatrist
 - Delusional disorders
 - Dissociative disorders
 - Personality disorders, especially borderline personality disorder
 - History of psychosis
- Cardiologist
 - Clinically significant uncontrolled Hypertension
 - Clinically significant arrhythmias such as prolonged QTc interval
 - Congestive heart failure, moderate to severe
 - Ischemic heart disease/angina
 - Structural heart disease, valvular, and cardiac hypertrophy
 - Known cerebral or aortic aneurysm

Exclusion: Patient that meet any of the following criteria are not eligible to participate in the Medical Psilocybin program.

- Disqualifying medications:
 - Used lithium in the past 30 days
 - Used and MAOIs in the past 30 days
- Disqualifying Conditions
 - Active psychosis
 - Having an allergy to mushrooms or other fungi
 - Current suicidal or homicidal ideation with intent, plan or inability to maintain safety
 - Pregnancy/Breastfeeding
