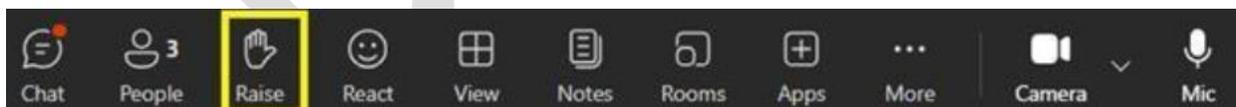

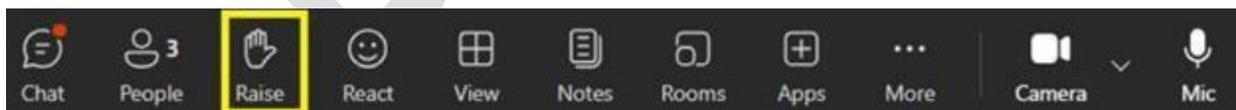


How to submit written public comments:

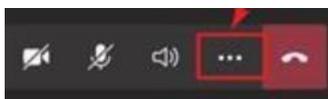
- Please send written public comment to the program email at: medical.psilocybin@doh.nm.gov and include the committee's name in the subject line.
