Sociocultural Domain (5 items)

These are the terms with zero MedDRA coverage, meaning they're entirely invisible to standard regulatory reporting:

Adverse change in worldview — Distressing shift in global beliefs about the world, one's place in it, or about others

Cultural invalidation — Negation, devaluation, or transgression against cultural norms, values, or commitments during treatment

Community strain — Conflict, rejection, loss of social status/capital, or difficulty integrating in one's community post-treatment

Stigma — Degradation, stereotyping, or devaluation by others (or internalized) based on personal characteristics or behavior

Distress associated with minoritized identity — Heightened salience and distress connected to minoritized group membership (e.g., minority stress for SGM patients)

Psychospiritual Domain (culturally adjacent)

Several of these overlap with cultural territory, particularly for patients whose cultural identity is inseparable from religious/spiritual identity:

Communal religious or spiritual struggles — Strain in relationship with one's religious/spiritual community

Undermining of spiritual worldview — Undesired challenge or violation of religious/spiritual beliefs during treatment

Religious or spiritual abuse — Harm in context of religious/spiritual activity, including coercion, exploitation, or manipulation

Religious or spiritual imposition — Unwanted imposition of religious/spiritual frameworks during treatment
