#### Department of Health (DOH) Has Ended Contracts with Four Providers

The New Mexico DOH has ended its contracts to be waiver providers with the following service providers:

- At Home Advocacy, Inc., Albuquerque
- A New Vision Case Management, Corrales
- Lynn Barbour, LLC, Albuquerque
- Sylvester & Company, Los Ranchos de Albuquerque

The DOH said that the contracts were ended for "Failure to ensure the safety and health of participants required immediate action for the well-being of participants." These providers will move their participants to other agencies no later than April 30, 2023. DOH Developmental Disabilities Supports Division will conduct faceto -face visits with participants every week until they are fully moved to their new providers.

## See Something Say Something

If you or anyone else is experiencing abuse, neglect, or exploitation (ANE) please say something. You, friends, or family **do not** have to live a life of abuse. Know what abuse is and who to report it to. In most cases you may remain anonymous.

"Abuse" including verbal abuse is knowingly, on purpose, and without basis causing:

- Physical pain
- Injury
- Mental hurt
- Sexual abuse

"**Neglect**" means the failure of the caretaker to provide basic needs of a person such as:

- Clothing
- Food
- Shelter
- Supervision
- Care for the physical
- Mental health of that person

Neglect causes or is likely to cause harm to a person.

"**Exploitation**" means an unfair or unacceptable use of a person's money or property for another person's profit or gain, financial, or otherwise.

Some people are hesitant to report suspected abuse because they are:

- Afraid they are wrong.
- They might be causing trouble.
- That it's none of their business.

In New Mexico, the law requires you to report abuse ANY TIME you suspect or know about any kind of abuse. Most importantly, always do the right thing. Be your own hero or a loved one's hero.

Customized Community Group supports can include:

- Taking part in group community day programs and community centers that offer activities that help with learning and holding on to growth in self-help, as well as flexible social skills for Mi Via participants.
- Customized community group supports may include adult day habilitation programs, and other types of programs that do not duplicate community direct support services, employment support services or any other waiver services.
- Customized community group supports are provided in blended community settings such as day programs and community centers. It is not provided in a person's home.
