










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Percentage of NM Adults Living in Households with Annual Income Less Than \$20,000



By Health Region, New Mexico, 2018-2020






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Percentage of NM Adults Living in Households with Annual Income of Less Than \$20,000

By Age Group, New Mexico, 2018-2020





By Urban and Rural Counties, New Mexico, 2018-2020





By Health Region, New Mexico, 2018-2020







By Age Group, New Mexico, 2018-2020





By Urban and Rural Counties, New Mexico, 2018-2020





By Health Region, New Mexico, 2018-2020






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Percentage of NM Adults Age 65+ without Health Care Coverage






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Percentage of NM Adults without Health Care Coverage



By Urban and Rural Counties, New Mexico, 2018-2020






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Percentage of Adults with Fair or Poor General Health Status



By Household Income, New Mexico, 2020





By Educational Attainment, New Mexico, 2020





By Age Group, New Mexico, 2020





By Race/Ethnicity, New Mexico, 2020





By Health Region, New Mexico, 2020





by Urban and Rural Counties, New Mexico, 2020










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Current Smokers by Educational Attainment










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Current Smoking by Urban & Rural Counties




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Oral Health Visit within Past Year



By Annual Household Income, NM, 2020 (Even Years Only)






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Percentage of Adults with an Oral Health Visit within the Past Year

By Educational Attainment, NM, 2020 (Even Years Only)





By Age Group, New Mexico, 2020 (Even Years Only)





By Race/Ethnicity, New Mexico, 2020 (Even Years Only)














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Percentage of NM Adults Who Were Obese (BMI ≥ 30), by Educational Attainment



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Percentage of NM Adults Who Were Obese (BMI ≥ 30) by Age Group











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By Gender and Educational Attainment, New Mexico, 2020





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










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Percentage of NM Adults with Diagnosed Diabetes by Educational Attainment








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Percentage of NM Adults With Diagnosed Diabetes by Health Region






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Percentage of Adults with Mental Distress














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Percentage of Adults with Mental Distress by Number of Chronic Health Conditions








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Current Drinking, Grades 9-12 by Urban and Rural Status







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








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Current Marijuana Use, Grades 9-12 by Health Region









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
Suicide Attempts and Suicidal Ideation, Grades 9 – 12, by Gender








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Forced Sexual Intercourse, Grades 9-12 by Health Region




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Forced Sexual Intercourse, Grades 9-12, by Urban and Rural Counties


























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Daily Preconception multivitamin or folic acid supplement among women with a live birth



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





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
Breastfeeding Initiation and duration among women with a live birth





* The standardized infection ratio (SIR) is a summary measure used to track infections over time. The SIR compares the actual number of infections to the number of expected infections given the standard population (national baseline). A SIR of greater than 1.0 indicates more infections than predicted and a SIR of less than 1.0 indicates fewer infections than predicted.




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Invasive Bacterial Infection Rates














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Pertussis Rates in Infants 0-6 Months of Age
















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







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
Number of Newly Reported Chronic Hepatitis C Infections by Case Status and Year*


Rate of Chronic Hepatitis C Infection by Age Group at diagnosis and Year*





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
New HIV Distribution Among Adults and Adolescents, Ages 13 and Older, by Gender






















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Primary and Secondary Syphilis Rates

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
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Primary & Secondary Syphilis Cases

By Sex, New Mexico, 2000-2020










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Percentage of Students Overweight and Obese by Gender




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Percentage of Kindergarten Students Overweight and Obese by Race/Ethnicity






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Percentage of Kindergarten Students Overweight and Obese by Race/Ethnicity


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Percentage of Third Grade Students Overweight and Obese by Race/Ethnicity




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Child Asthma Hospitalization Rates, Ages 0-17 Years




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Heat-Related Illness Hospitalizations and Emergency Department Visit Rates by Region


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
Heat-Related Illness Emergency Department Visits by Month and Year




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Neonatal Abstinence Syndrome





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










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Diabetes Hospitalization Rates by Region


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Emergency Department Visit Rates by Age













By Health Region, New Mexico, 2020





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


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Life Expectancy Trend by Sex








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Infant Mortality Rates by Urban & Rural Counties



New Mexico, 1930 – 2020 and U.S., 1930-2019











Infant Deaths per 1,000 Live Births


















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Heart Disease Death Rates by Race/Ethnicity


















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Unintentional Injury Death Rates by Health Region


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Unintentional Injury Death Rates by Urban and Rural Counties










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Violent Death Rates*








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Suicide Death Rates by Age Group


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Suicide Death Rates by Urban and Rural Counties










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Firearm Injury Death Rates by Urban and Rural Counties








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Chronic Liver Disease Death Rates by Urban and Rural Counties






New Mexico and U.S., 1990-2020













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


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
Disability-Adjusted Life Years (DALYs)









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Highlights

General Conclusions

- Health status is inversely associated with poverty at the community level.
- Indicators with greater than twice the risk for persons living in high poverty areas include: teen birth, deaths due to chronic liver disease, diabetes, influenza and pneumonia.
- Chronic disease mortality rates continue to decrease in New Mexico.
- Injury and substance abuse death rates are stable or increasing.
- The infant mortality rate reduction in NM is a success story but disparities remain.
- Geographic, socioeconomic and racial/ethnic disparities persist in NM, particularly in rural areas.
