







## Demographics



Ethnicity is asked as a two-part question when patients register. Here are the results:












### Active Enrolled Patients December 2021 to December 2025



### Number of Patients Enrolled Most Commonly Enrolled Qualifying Conditions: December 2021 to December 2025






### Percentage of Patients Enrolled Most Commonly Enrolled Qualifying Conditions: December 2021 to December 2025
