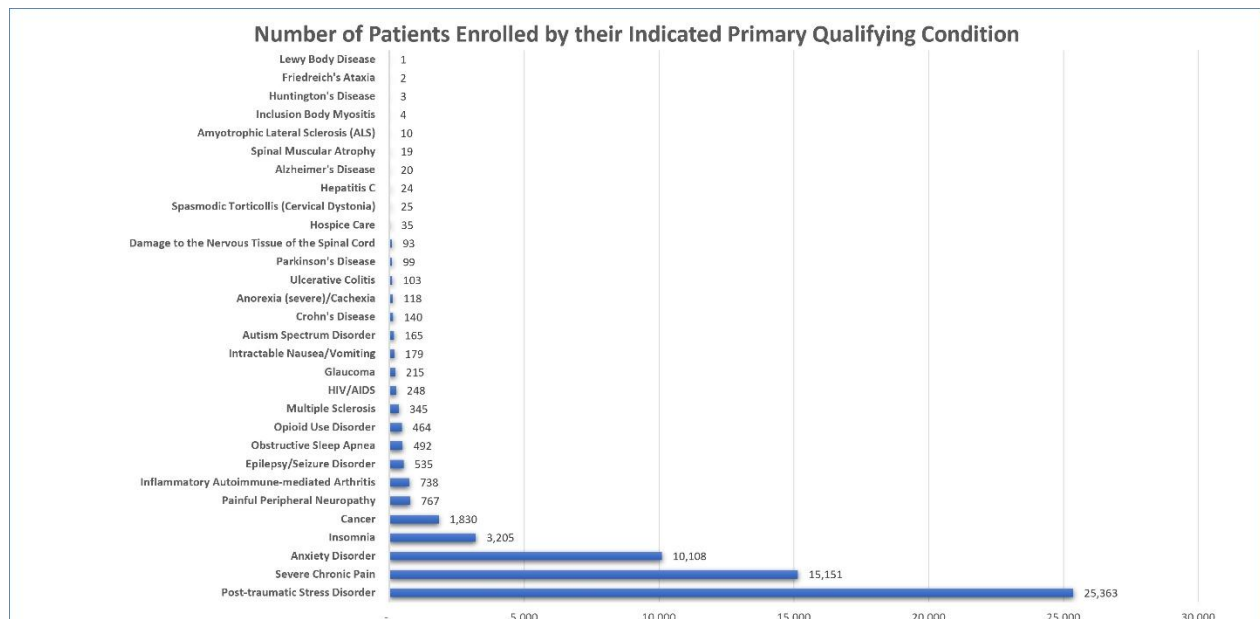

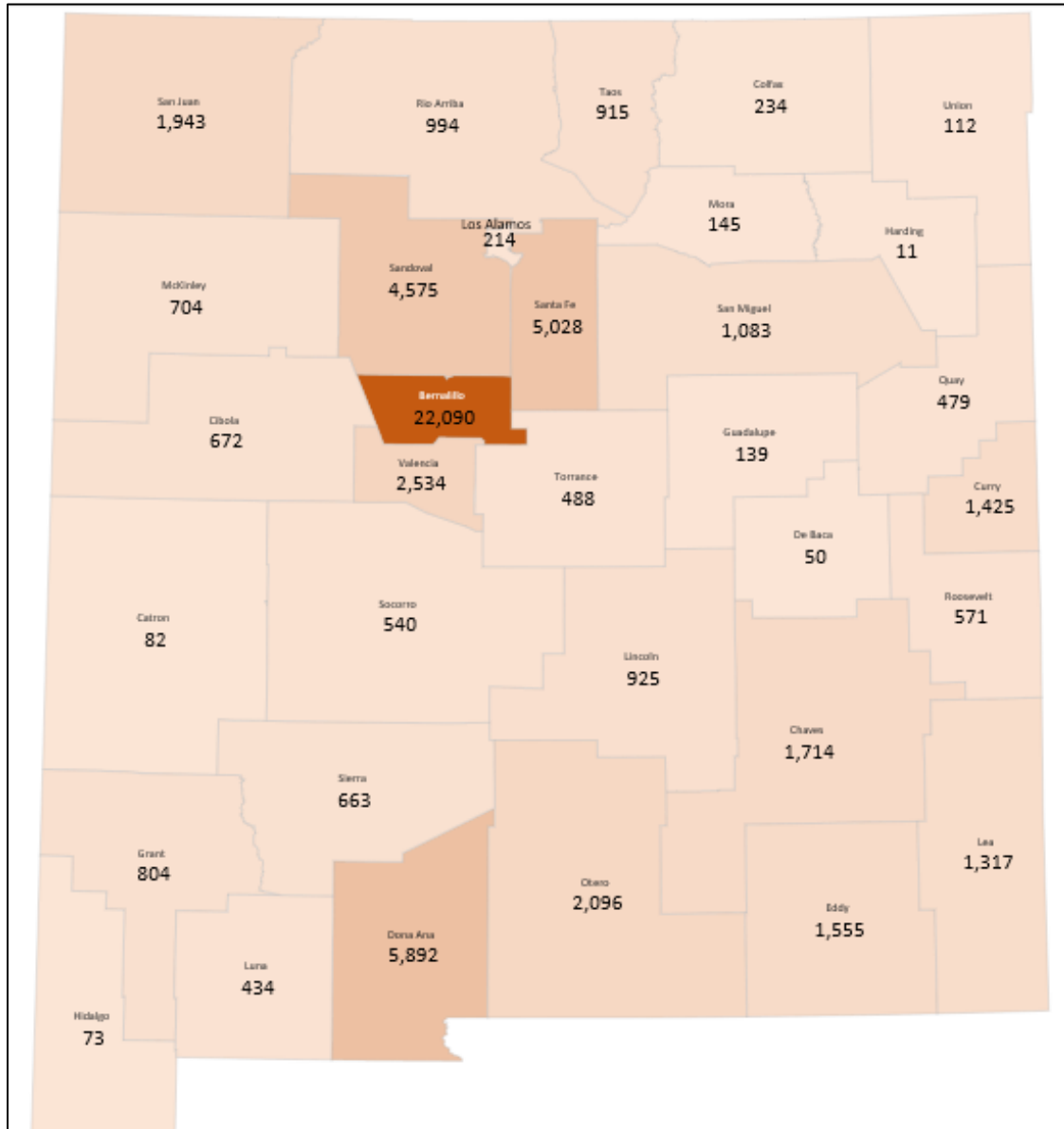

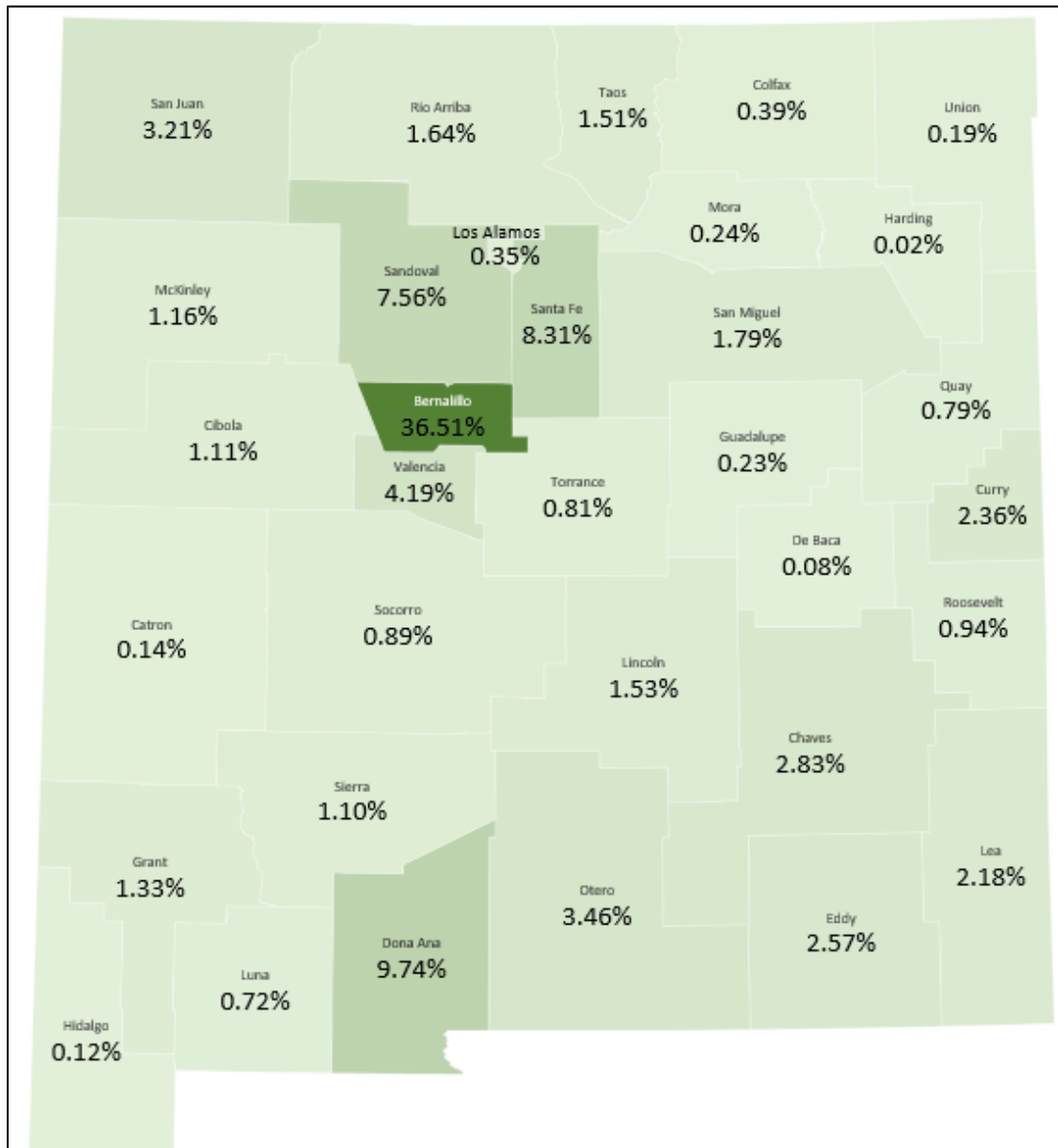

Demographics

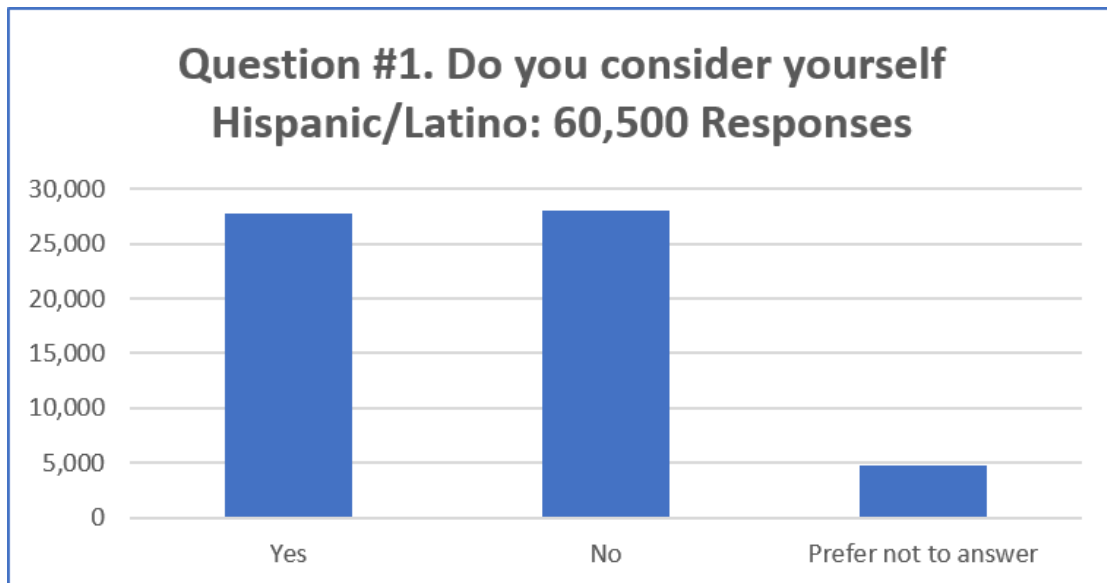

Ethnicity is asked as a two-part question when patients register. Here are the results:

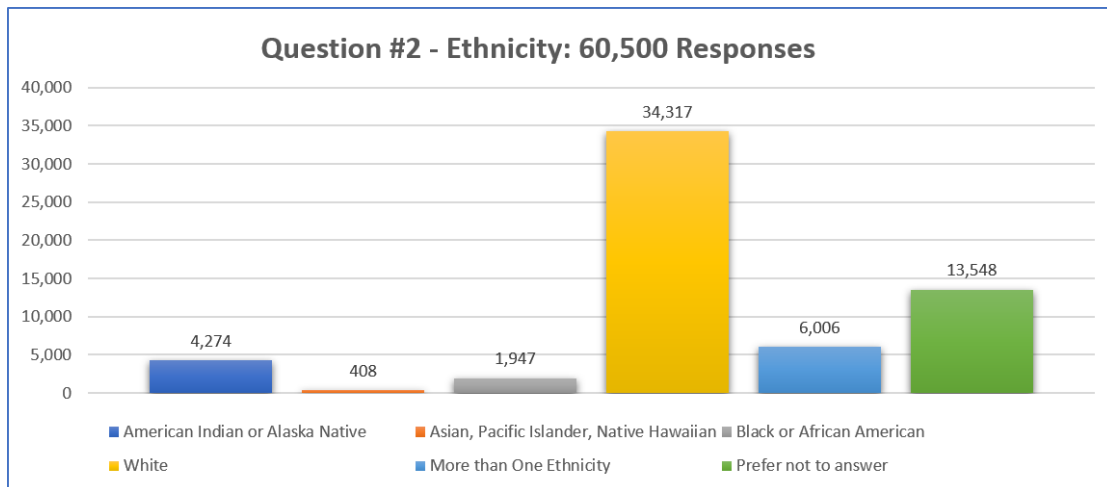

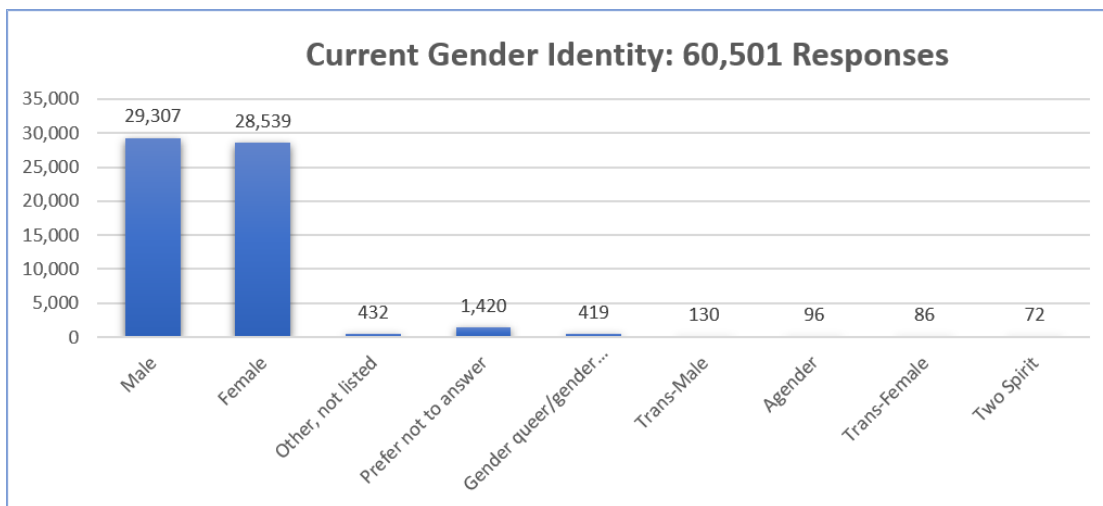

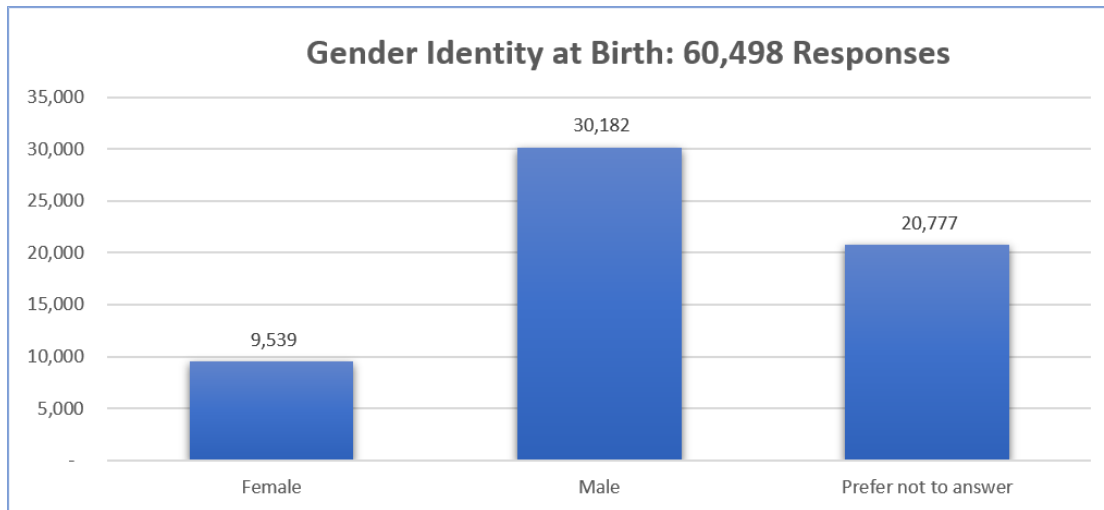

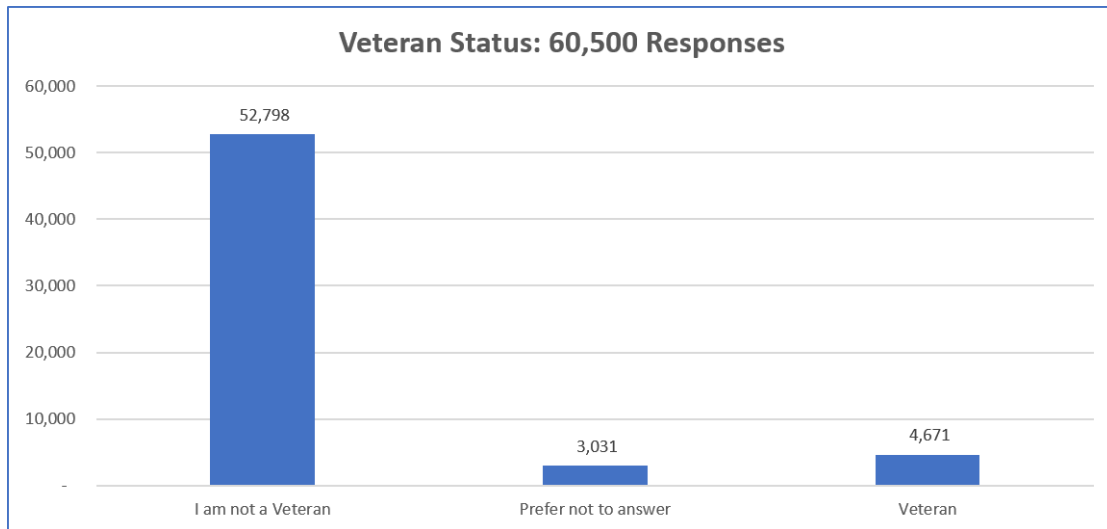

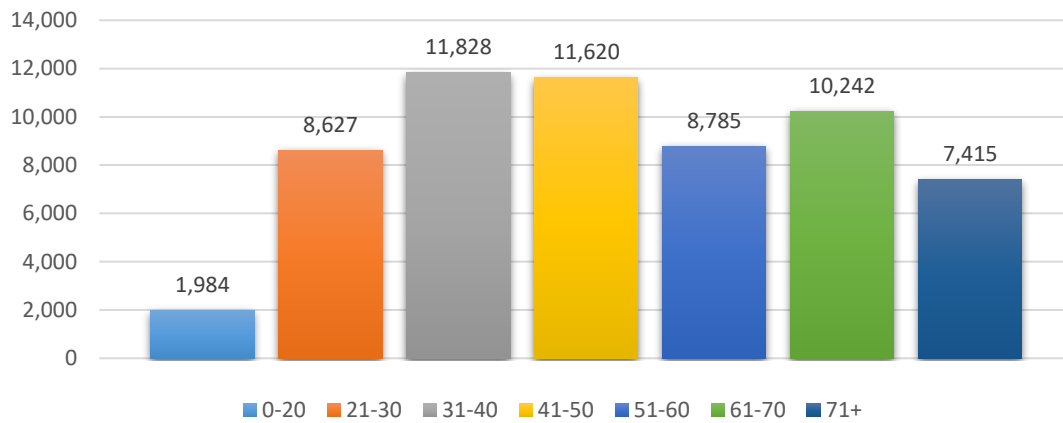

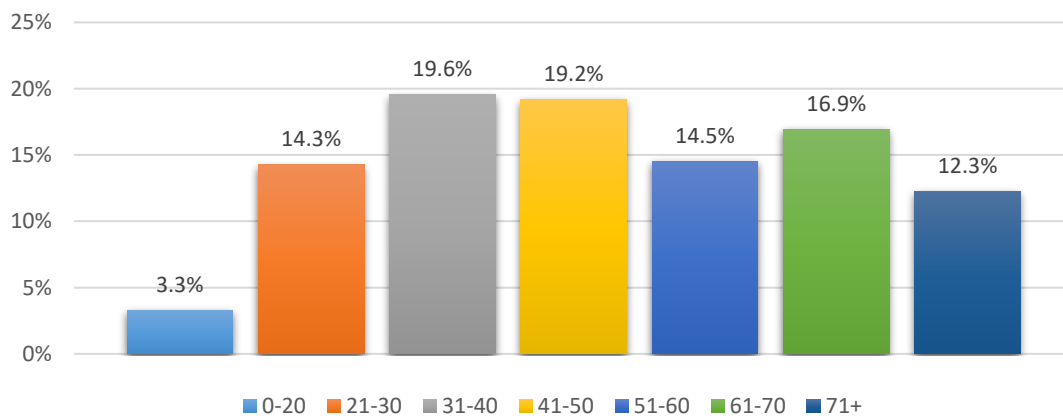

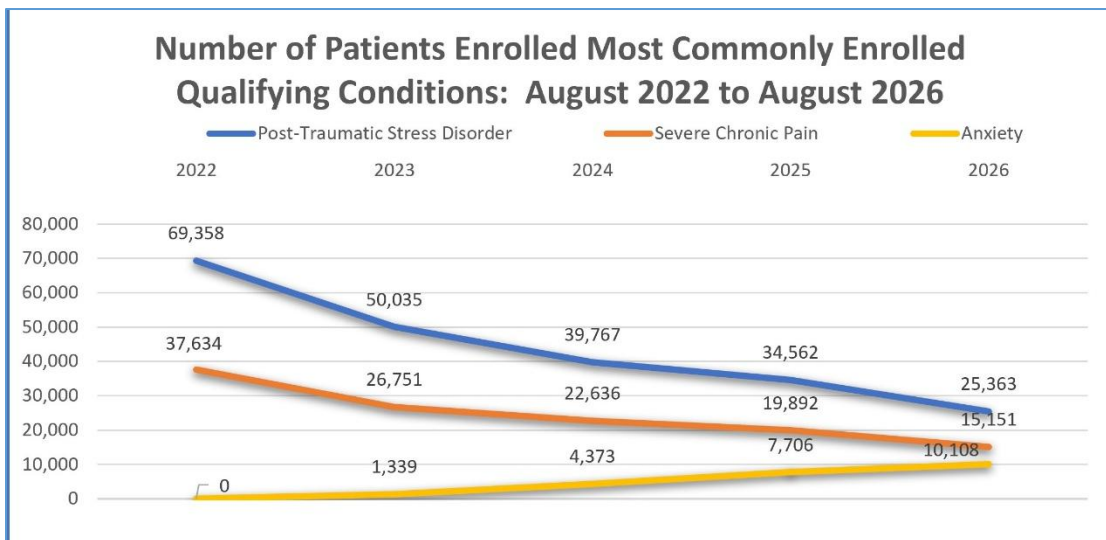
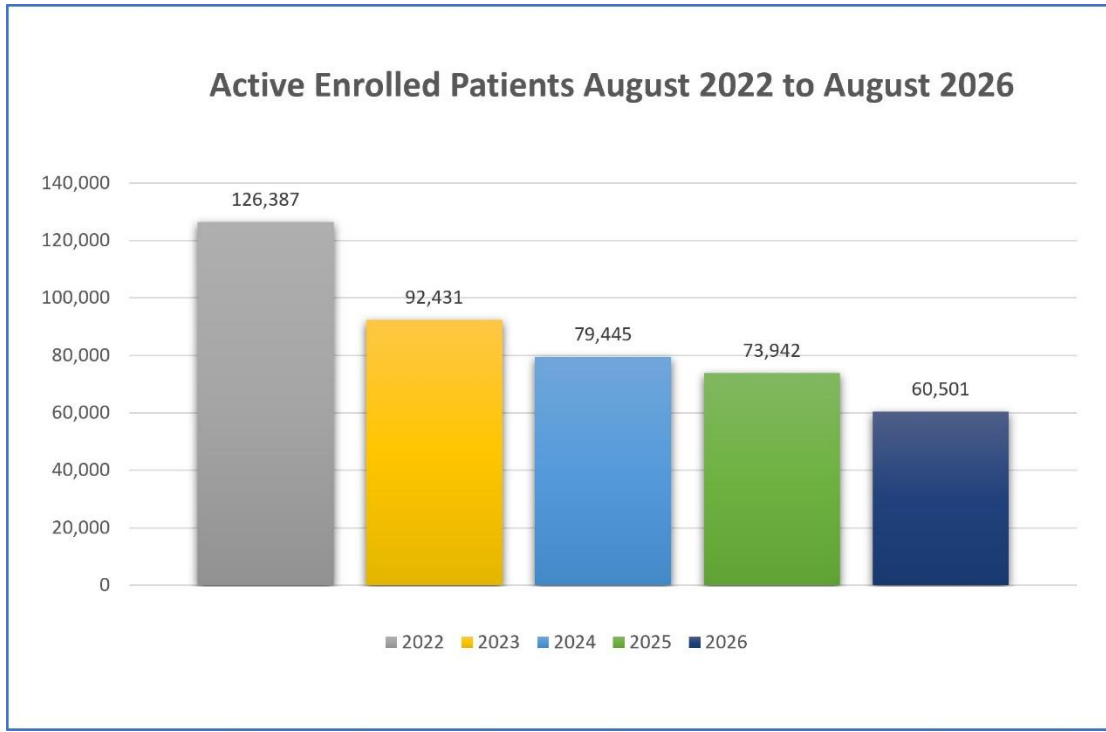
Number of Individuals Enrolled by Age



Percentages of Individuals Enrolled by Age

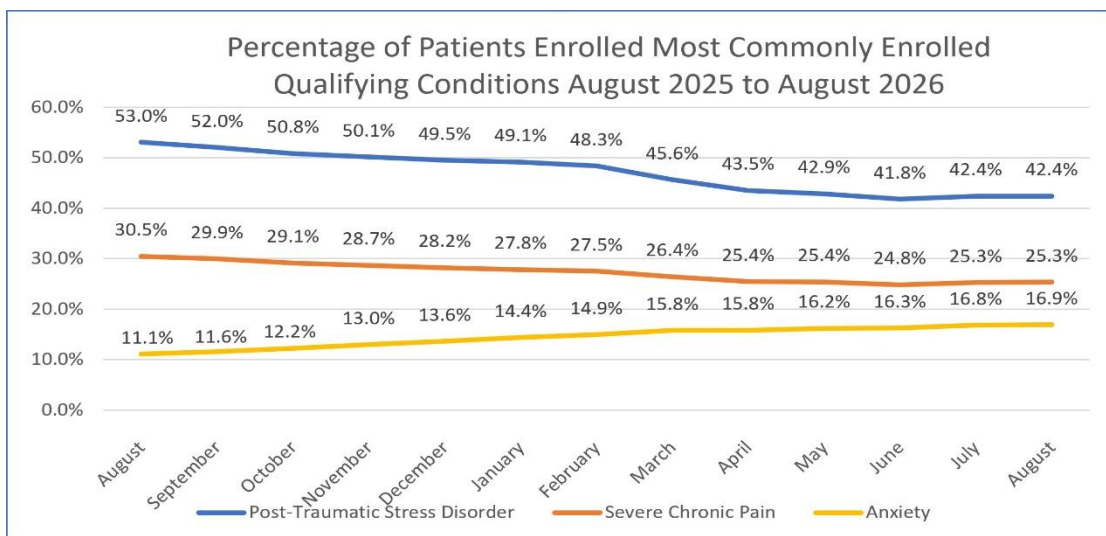
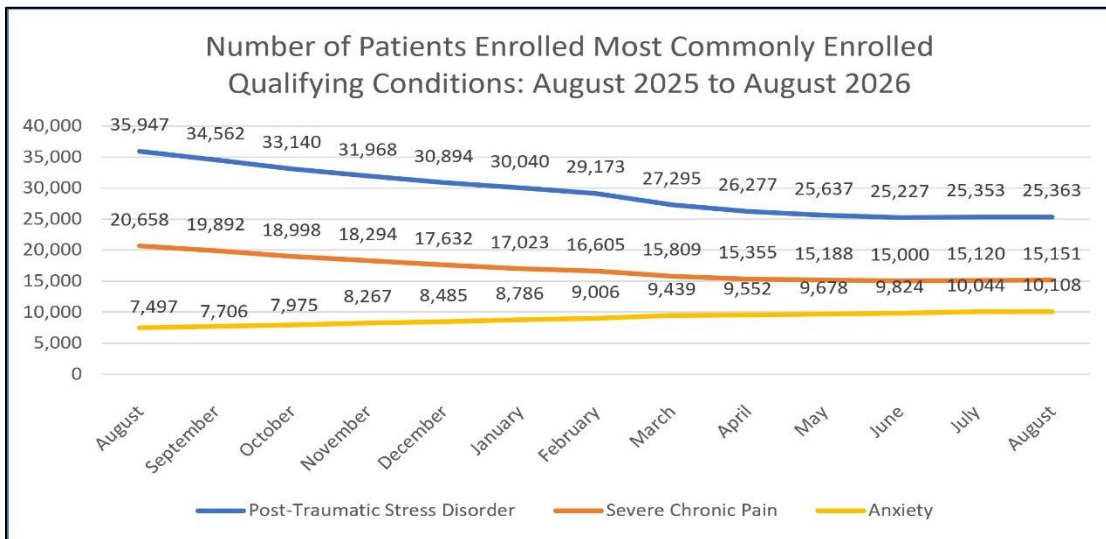
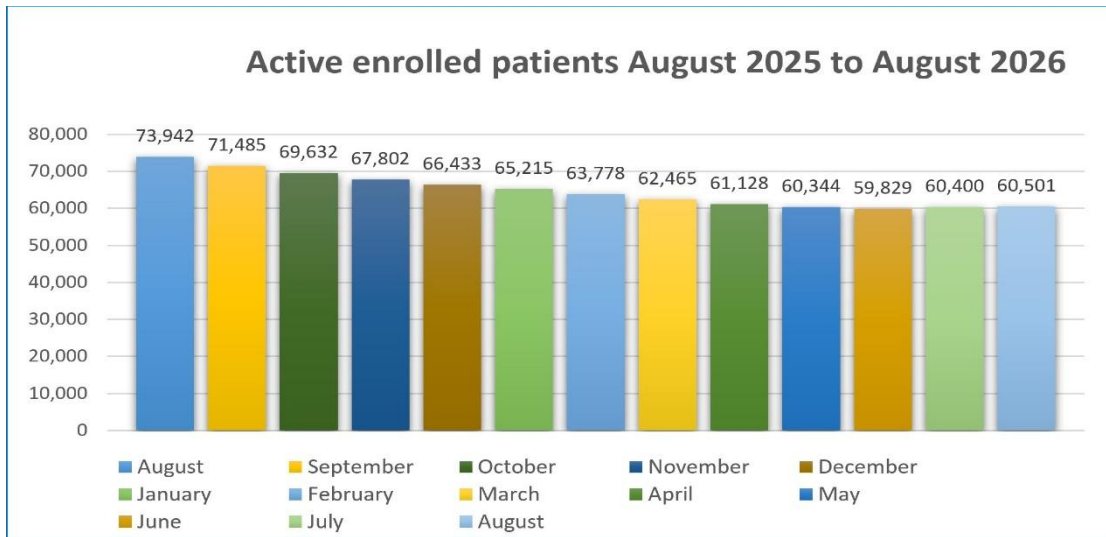


Five-Year Enrollment Trends
